







Faith Preparatory School Reopening Plan Highlights

	<p>Stay home if you feel ill Students, teachers, and staff must stay home if they are feeling sick, have any symptoms consistent with COVID-19, or have had close contact with a person diagnosed with COVID-19.</p>
	<p>Morning health check by parents required. In order to prevent transmission among the school population, check temperature every morning to ensure it is below 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit and observe for symptoms associated with COVID-19 outlined by public health officials.</p> <p>Teachers and staff are expected to self-screen before leaving for school. Parents are instructed to screen students before leaving for school. Temperatures of students, teachers, and staff will be checked upon arrival.</p>
	<p>Face coverings or masks required in common areas Students must wear face coverings or masks completely covering the nose and mouth when entering and exiting the building, in common areas, hallways, and on busses, with exceptions only for those for whom it is not safe to do so due to medical conditions or disabilities. Parents will be responsible for providing students with face coverings or masks. The school office will have backup disposable masks available for students who forget them.</p> <p>Teachers and staff must wear face coverings or masks completely covering the nose and mouth when entering and exiting the building, in common areas, and hallways, with exceptions only for those for whom it is not safe to do so due to medical conditions or disabilities. The school office will have backup disposable masks available for teachers and staff.</p>
	<p>Frequent hand washing or hand sanitizing expected Students, teachers, and staff must engage in frequent hand washing or sanitizing upon arrival, before and after meals, after bathroom use, and after coughing or sneezing.</p>
	<p>School busses Face coverings or masks are required on New Milford buses and the Danbury van. Temperature checks will be taken by the Danbury van driver. Parents are strongly urged to drive their children to school each day.</p>
